EIGHT ROUNDS

A Racing Hondas round is about more than just racing: every round is a celebration of car culture. The eight one-day meetings mean a lower cost for teams while delivering plenty of track time and high-octane racing. Racing Hondas has a maximum 32 cars on the grid, although some rounds are able to expand where track licences allow.

Entrants' cars are performance-balanced to keep the racing close: this is managed by a closely monitored set of power to weight rules and dyno testing/engine sealing.

Timing for the championship is high-level and provided by leading industry suppliers, TSL Timing Solutions.

There are championship podium presentations at each round and an end-of-season gala trophy presentation. Racing Hondas has its own dedicated space in the paddock at each track along with extensive branding. There is also modestly priced pre-event testing available, organised by the circuits.

Our 2026 championship calendar features eight rounds across premier MSV venues, including Cadwell Park, Donington Park, Brands Hatch, Oulton Park, and Snetterton.

Each round will also host one of our flagship off-track car shows, offering an enhanced experience for fans and partners alike.

We organise not only the championship but also each of the car shows in their entirety to bring together the world of car enthusiasts and relevant racing all on one day - it's a combination unique to Club Time Attack and what ensures our events are 'must-see' and full of amazing things to see both on and off track.

BALANCED PERFORMANCE

The championship is open to most Honda models and runs to a carefully controlled three-class structure, which adds excitement and opportunity for everyone taking part. Engines must be those used broadly across the Honda range and are normally aspirated except in Class A, where supercharging is also permitted.

According to their individual power-to-weight ratio, cars are allocated to Class A, B and the new for 2026 S2000 Cup. According to its respective weight, each car is then given its own power allowance (up to the maximum output permitted in its class).

Powers, weights and ratios are recorded and calculated using championship technical partner Tegiwa's dynamometer facility. This ensures consistency and transparency for competitors.

CLASS A

Class A is for more powerful 'prototype' race-spec cars and has been described by some as being a place for 'the ultimate Honda'.

Class A include Integra DC2s and DC5s, plus both newer and older shape Civics including EG, EK, EP3 and FK2.

A deliberately worded set of technical regulations helps keep a lid on costs but also allows those who enjoy making modifications the freedom to experiment in areas such as aerodynamics, transmissions and suspension.



CLASS B

Type R Civic EP3s and FN2s have become the mainstay of Class B and this leads to some incredibly tight racing within the class.

The class rules are designed to keep the cars closely matched, managed by the power-to-weight ratio brackets and dyno testing and sealed engines.

The class attracts cars that were originally built as 'Civic Cup' cars however the Racing Hondas Championship is far less restrictive and allows drivers to run many components without control – such as exhausts, suspension, cages, ECUs as well as using big brake kits to reduce overall running costs for discs and pads.

New for 2026, welcoming another Honda icon to our grids is the S2000R specification one-make racing car, developed specifically for the championship and close-quarters racing.

Shakedown of the prototype 001 car showed it's an incredibly precise and fun car with ultimate pace coming from an edgy setup to make for exhilarating driving.

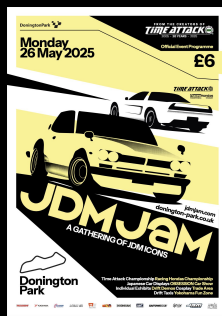

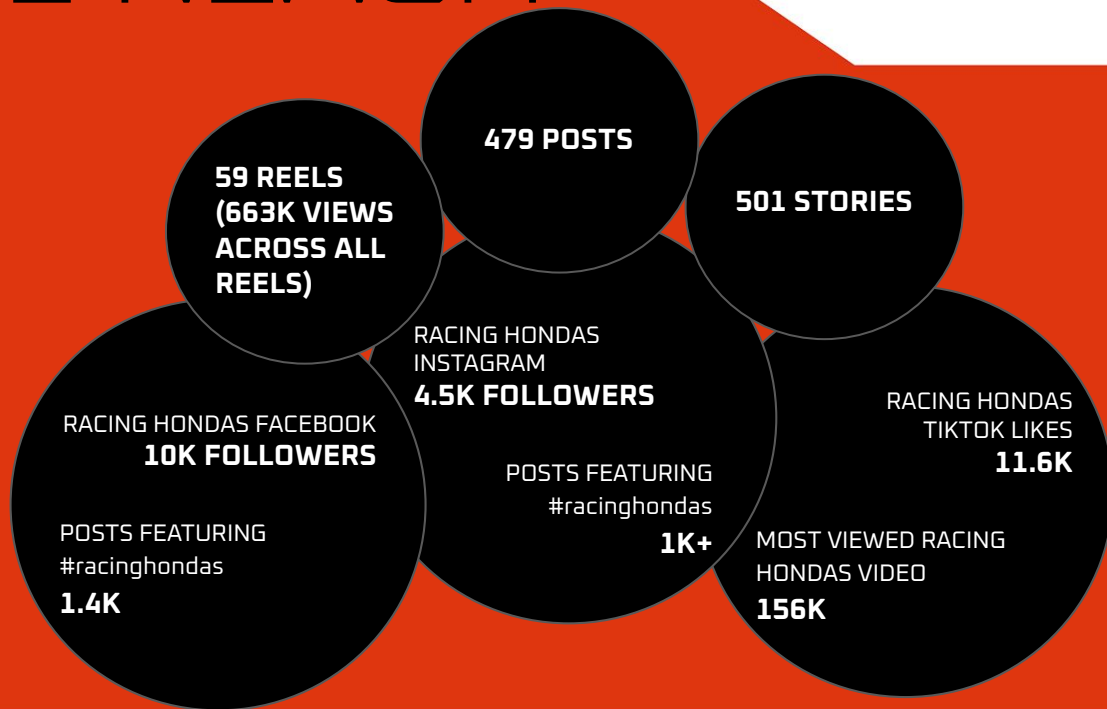
MEDIA STRATEGY

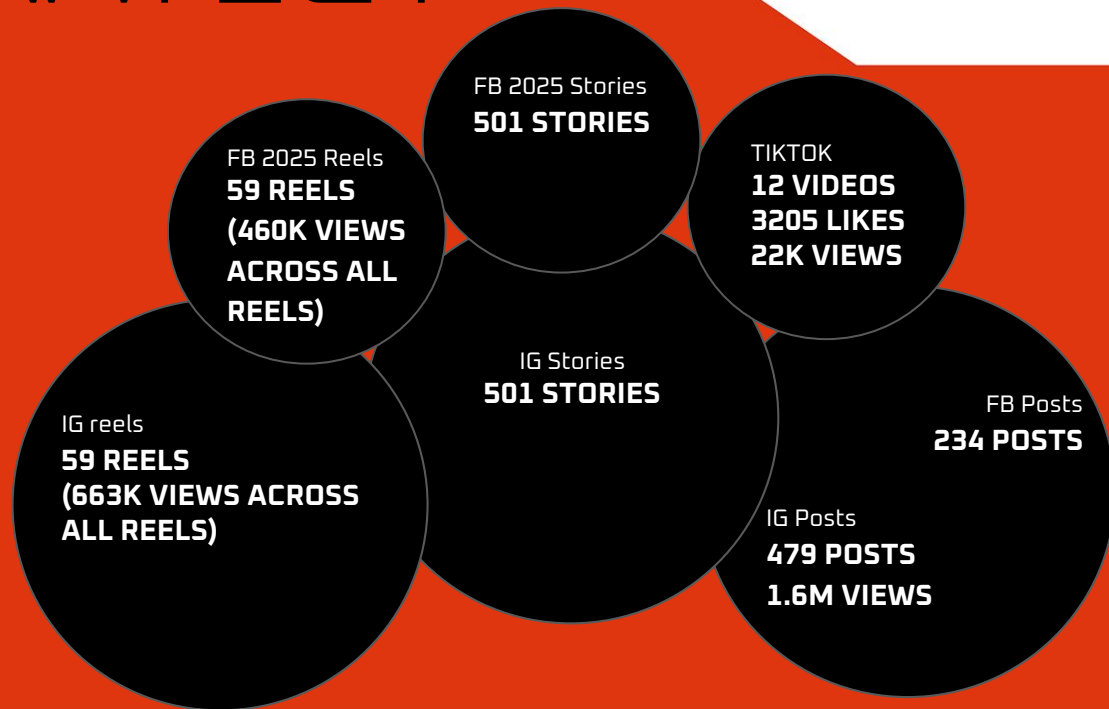
SOCIAL STRATEGY

COMPETING

The Racing Hondas Championship offers exceptional value for money. £3,520 (including VAT) covers championship registration and entry fees to all eight of the 2026 season's events if paid by 1st March 2026 which is exceptional for this level of championship.

Alternative options include paying the registration fee of £290 by 1st March and then entry fees on a round-by-round basis at £440 per event.

The registration fee (£290) is optional but it ensures a driver is eligible to score points and secures them their preferred race number at all events they enter.

Entries are accepted up to 15 days prior to each event. Those received later than this will incur a £50 late payment fee, which will be donated to Club Time Attack's chosen registered charity at season's end.

Drivers are required to be members of Club Time Attack, which costs £100 a year and is handled as part of the registration process.
